7:06 PM	<p>Review UIP and MAP data</p> <p>Board Membership</p>	<p>Review UIP and MAP data</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● General Observations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Two Roads Chooses MAP testing over other options because it offers more data points and consistent and timely information.</li> <li>○ The UIP continues to be built upon each year rather than starting fresh.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● The most current SPF accreditation rating is accredited with 95% participation in testing.</li> <li>● The document goes over action plan goals started after Fall of 2019. There were no questions.</li> <li>● Wonders curriculum is a literacy curriculum for k-5. Two Roads replaced Lucy Calkin’s with Wonders this school year.</li> <li>● We reviewed the performance targets for math and reading, noting that students are already very close to meeting growth goals set for spring.</li> <li>● For clarification: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Only scores for full time students are used for the UIP. This is because homeschool students are not required to test so participation may be inconsistent. Also, Two Roads is not considered the primary educator for homeschool students.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● What is the READ Act: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The goal is for students to be reading at grade level by 3rd grade. Students who don’t meet that target are put on a reading plan to help them catch up. The hope is that they can go off their reading plan by 6th grade.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
