Elementary Reading BINGO

As homeschool families, you do a lot of reading at home. The Reading BINGO is an individual reading challenge. It is not required, but a fun way for students to show how much reading they do each month and it encourages them to try out new topics and explore new authors. Books can be read independently, or by a parent, sibling, etc. Students may also read aloud to their favorite pet or stuffed animal. Each month the Reading BINGO sheet will be given to students at school. Students must complete a BINGO (vertical, horizontal, diagonal and even a black out counts), the form must have the student's name and be signed by a parent or guardian. Remember to make sure your student's name and parent signature are filled in and turn it in by the due date listed at the top to be eligible for a prize.

Student Dress Code

Please speak to your child to ensure our student dress code (page 20 of our Two Roads Family Handbook) is followed at school.

Dress Code

Students, staff and families are expected to dress in a manner that denotes self-respect and does not cause, or has the potential of causing, embarrassment, derisive or derogatory comments, or disruption.

- Undergarments (with the exception of bra straps) should not be exposed at any time.
- Footwear is required at all times.
- Hats and hoodies worn up over the head may not be worn in school buildings (exceptions may include school sponsored events or spirit days).
- Students are not allowed to wear clothing with gang symbols, sexual content, or content deemed inappropriate (included but not limited to drug or alcohol references).
- Students enrolled in a Physical Education class are expected to dress appropriately. Athletic shoes are required – students without appropriate footwear will not be permitted to participate..

If a student's dress or appearance is deemed as inappropriate or disruptive in any way, the student will be **asked to correct the situation.** Parents/guardians may be called to assist the student in obtaining the appropriate attire. Refusal by the student to comply will result in disciplinary action up to and including suspension.

Traffic for Drop-Off & Pick-Up

There is a lot of construction traffic around the facility. It is imperative that all drivers adhere to the traffic pattern and safety! Slow down and watch for children walking through the parking lot and use the crosswalk.



Secondary Students - Students can be dropped off and picked up outside.

Elementary Students - Elementary students can be dropped off or you may walk them inside each morning. Please come inside to pick up your child(ren) at the end of the school day. All teachers will walk their last period class to the Hub at the end of the day. Teachers will remain with students until all are picked up.

*** All kindergarten students must be walked to their classroom each morning by a parent.
