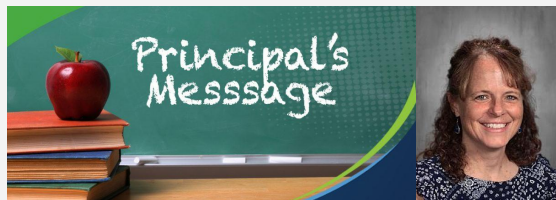

Thank you for taking time to complete the School Accountability Committee Survey. Your feedback is greatly appreciated. We take each comment into consideration, discussing areas of success, strength and growth opportunities. Our goal is to provide the best possible homeschool partnership program for your family.

Questions Asked:

- **Why are students graded on something that is completely subjective?** Great question! Each class at Two Roads is designed to teach students a set of standards or specific skills. The standards determine the direction of the class and provide teachers and students with learning outcomes. Teachers communicate to their students what they are supposed to be learning and what mastery looks like for each lesson or unit. Students are assessed on the skills and content area knowledge for each course and earn a grade based on their ability to demonstrate the skills. Instruction and assessment of standards vary by developmental level of the student and the course. Some examples of assessment include observation, project, essay, presentation, test, quiz, class discussion, etc.
- **Is it possible to have shorter commitment time periods for volunteer hours?** If you see a role you would like to fill but cannot commit to the full time period, please reach out to Mrs. Donow. We are happy to work with you and thrilled to have people in the building to help in any capacity.
- **It would be nice to have more community events to get to know families.** (This was asked a lot in the survey.) We host and participate in a variety of events throughout the school year such as the Fall Festival (here at Waterstone), Chatfield day to swim, Homecoming, Pumpkin Decorating Contest, dress up days, parent coffees and movie nights. In the past we've had parents offer after school clubs or classes as well as organize field trips. Just two weeks ago, we had a parent volunteer for as a field trip organizer. She has already set up a field trip to Hammond's Candy Factory and the Denver Zoo. We've had parents host clubs after school for fencing, running, writing, Legos and Yoga. 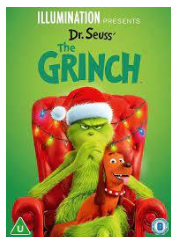

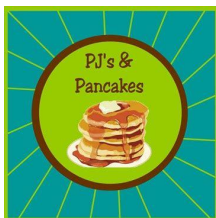
