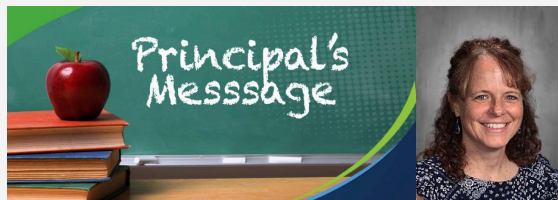

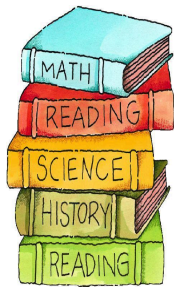

Water For South Sudan UPDATE

The 6th grade English class recently finished the book *A Long Walk to Water*. The book is a true story about the 'Lost Boys' of the Sudanese Civil War. One boy, Salva Dut, was among the hundreds of refugees chosen to go to the U.S. When he arrived, he started the organization called Water For South Sudan. The organization drills wells for the 60% of Sudan's population without clean water. 628 wells have been drilled and 412 wells have been fixed. \$2 can give a person clean water for a whole year.

The sixth-grade English class is excited to announce that Two Roads donated \$451.59 to Water for South Sudan. Thank you so much to all who donated! This will provide clean water for 225 people for a year as well as improve the health, economy, and opportunities for girls to have an education in a community in South Sudan.
