SAT and PSAT

All full-time 9th, 10th and 11th graders, and homeschool students who signed up with Mrs. Abeyta by the February deadline, will take the **PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, or SAT on Thursday**,

April 18th. Please arrive at the Arvada campus by 7:45 a.m. and wait outside the front office to be directed to your testing room. Students who arrive late may not be permitted to test. **Students will be provided a testing ticket in their testing room.** Please review the following:

- There is a calculator embedded in the navigation bar of each test. If you prefer a hand-held calculator please review the acceptable models here:

- Do NOT bring your phone into the testing room.

- Bring at least two sharpened pencils; any type is fine since the test will be taken on a school-provided Chromebook; personal devices are not permitted.
- You will not be permitted into any building except the building in which you are testing.
- Students will be dismissed to go home immediately following the completion of the test.
- End times are approximate:
 - PSAT and SAT: 7:45-11:00 a.m.
 - SAT with Essay: 7:45 a.m.-12:00 p.m.


