

High School Credit Recovery Offered at Arvada West

Arvada West's **credit recovery** summer school is a hybrid program with a curriculum provided through <u>Edgenuity</u> online with **Mandatory IN PERSON TESTS**. Students need to provide their own chromebooks. *A Special Education teacher is available at school Monday - Thursday 8-11 am*.

Registration: IN PERSON <u>May 28th from 8 am - 11am</u> at Arvada West High School. Classes:

Face to Face Sessions are at Arvada West HS in the library and commons based on subject area (8-11 am Mon -Thurs **No class Juneteenth) **ALL TESTS (Pre-test, Unit Test, Final Test) MUST be taken IN PERSON.** *Work with the specific teacher if you will be absent, attendance requirements are subject and teacher specific*

Monday & Wednesday (8-11am) Math & Science

Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry, Statistics, Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Science, Integrated Science

Tuesday & Thursday (8-11am) English & Social Studies

English 9, English 10, English 11,
English 12,
US History, US Government, World Geography,
World History, Economics

Courses: Can take credit recovery at no charge with a **two course MAXIMUM**. Be sure to know and understand your transcript or speak to your home school counselor to sign up for the proper courses.

Deadlines:

- June 3: Classes Start
- June 27: End of Session

On Track to complete in six weeks:

- June 6th = 25%
- June 13th = 50%
- June 20th = 75%
- June 27th = 100%
- 90% of the course at a passing grade of 65% or higher for Credit Recovery

If you want to enroll, please follow the instructions and come to Arvada West High School on May 28th to complete the registration process in person between 8am -11 am.

If you fill out the form, you are registered and should plan to attend classes the week of June 3rd based on the subject you are signed up for in the chart above.

Dress Code Reminder

As the weather heats up, please be reminded of our school dress code as published in our Two Roads Family Handbook:

Students, staff and families are expected to dress in a manner that denotes self-respect and does not cause, or has the potential of causing, embarrassment, derisive or derogatory comments, or disruption.

- Undergarments (with the exception of bra straps) should not be exposed at any time.
- Footwear is required at all times.
- Hats and hoodies worn up over the head MAY NOT be worn in school buildings (exceptions
 may include school sponsored events or spirit days).

- Students are not allowed to wear clothing with gang symbols, sexual content, or content deemed inappropriate (included but not limited to drug or alcohol references).
- Students enrolled in a Physical Education class are expected to dress appropriately. Athletic shoes are required students without appropriate footwear will not be permitted to participate. In addition, in Arvada a school issued PE shirt should be worn to every PE class.

If a student's dress or appearance is deemed as inappropriate or disruptive in any way, the student will be asked to correct the situation. Parents/guardians may be called to assist the student in obtaining the appropriate attire. Refusal by the student to comply will result in disciplinary action up to and including suspension.

There may be special school-sponsored activities at which costumes or special clothing might be allowed. Even so, *our own dignity and the respect for others* should be our mindset at all times. These would include prom, theatrical performances, talent show, school dances, field day, and other school sponsored events.


